Coming Soon: The Lendery

County residents who use the Library will soon have another way to pick up their materials. The Lendery will soon be available at the Wellington Resource Centre in Clairmont thanks to a partnership between the Grande Prairie Public Library, the County of Grande Prairie Community Libraries, and Peace Library System.

The Lendery is a collection of smart lockers that offers a secure, alternative location for library users to pick up books, DVDs and other materials. "We are pleased to offer an additional access point for library users to pick up their items," says Hailey McCullough, GPPL's Head of Adult Services. "We are grateful to our partners for working with us, as well as for the financial support of the Government of Alberta, the Willie Janssen Legacy Fund and the County of Grande Prairie."

Those who wish to pick up their items at The Lendery will be able to place requests online beginning on Monday, August 30. The first day items can be picked up from the smart lockers will be Tuesday, September 7.

"When placing a request online, a user can select Clairmont – Grande Prairie Public as the pick-up location if they wish to pick up their items from The Lendery," explains McCullough. "After the materials have been delivered to the locker, the user can scan their library card and input their PIN to retrieve their items."

The Lendery will be accessible at the Wellington Resource Centre from Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.
